The original concept was an emphasis on rotation of art works owned by the St. Louis County Historical Society, with the production of museum standard exhibit labels and museum standard installation of exhibits; this will be pursued in the future, drawing from the Society's extensive collection of art.

St. Louis County administration authorized funding for the Society to implement a long-term courthouse exhibit project for the Virginia and Hibbing courthouses in 2014, which installation was completed in 2015, after the cases were constructed by St. Germain's and transported to the courthouses. Currently the Virginia exhibit features the Virginia Citizens WWI Service Contribution exhibit, with artifacts from the Virginia Area Historical Society. The Hibbing courthouse case exhibit features the Hibbing High School, with exhibit
